Comparing more than one FOCUSED REVIEW



After completing a FOCUSED REVIEW, do **NOT** discard the downloaded report!!

IF you need to complete more than one FOCUSED REVIEW (i.e. you did not get at least a 70% on a practice or proctored exam), you can COMPARE the reports to see if you are still missing the same topics.

Comparing reports helps you to identify areas that need additional studying because you have missed questions on those topics more than once.

Remember that good preparation for the ATI exam is also good preparation for the NCLEX-PN exam!
